eIRB Tip of the Month- May 2018

Disabling Pop-Up Blocker– Updated*

eIRB uses pop-up windows to present users with information, as well as to ask questions and confirm actions. <u>In order</u> for the system to function properly, pop-up blocker should always be disabled when using the eIRB site. This action may need to be taken more than once, especially on University computers which receive automatic updates from ITS that may reset functions. <u>NOTE: eIRB will no longer (as of May 2018) allow ANY system activity until pop-up blocker</u> has been disabled. Use the steps below to disable pop-up blocker and access the system.



NOTE: Using the browser bar prompt on Firefox will produce a tiny window that may be confusing. If using the browser bar prompt on Firefox- (1) close the tiny window, (2) click 'Quit' on the warning message, and (3) log in again.
